Suggested packing list - please note the weather can be changeable in The Netherlands at this time of year – it can be cold and wet and also hot and sunny!

Walking boots

Warm shirts

Warm jumpers

Warm trousers

A pair of shorts

2 x T-shirts

Changes of underwear

Indoor 'normal' everyday clothes

Toothbrush/shampoo/soap/deodorant etc.

Medicine (if required)

Camera

Pocket money (we suggest at least 100 euros)

Swimming costume (for the beach)

Flip flops and sandals (for the beach and the tropical temperatures at the warm companies)

Sunglasses

Sport shoes (trainers/sneakers) for working and sport activities

Suntan lotion and aftersun

Washing Machine

There are washing machines at the accommodation.

Meals

All food will be provided.

The accommodation in The Netherlands is self catering, which means that you will prepare your meals yourself in the kitchen. The necessary shopping will be organised for you.

Breakfast will be at your accommodation.

Lunch will be a "packed" lunch to be prepared by yourself and taken with you to school or to your work placement.

Warm evening meals will be eaten together with the other students at your accommodation and will be prepared for by yourself.

During activities other eating arrangements may apply. You will be told in advance what these arrangements are, if there are any changes.
