


CZECH SYSTEM OF OCCUPATIONS AND QUALIFICATIONS

NATIONAL SYSTEM OF OCCUPATIONS

Tasks:

- Cooperation with Sector boards
- Monitoring of individual occupation requirements
- Monitoring of labour market and consequent proposals

Provides:

- Register of occupations
 - Information for human resources areas and professional lifelong learning
 - Employer role reinforcement
 - Base for future mobility and flexibility at labour market
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National System of Qualifications NSQ

The system is based on requirements for performance of activities in individual occupations

NSQ allows :

- Identification of qualifications
- Classification of qualifications
- Certification

NSQ forms:

- Connecting system framework for initial and further education

NSQ allows:

- Comparison of our national qualifications with European qualifications

Responsible: Ministry of Education, Youths and Sports



National System of Qualifications NSQ

NSQ serves as a register of complete and partial qualifications recognized in the CR.

- ability to perform specific occupation;
usually corresponds to the particular
education

complete qualification

- ability to perform specific activity or more
activities at the labour market.

partial qualification

- examinations according to the evaluation
standards of the partial qualifications
performed by authorized persons



National System of Qualifications NSQ

Creation of the NSQ

- creation of the proposals of the qualification and evaluation standards in expert teams
- discussions, assessment and modifications of qualification and evaluation standards in sector boards
- evaluation and approval of qualification and evaluation standards by the Ministry of Education and authorized bodies
